

Greetings!

FHN and the Freeport Public Library are already planning for the holiday season!

You are invited to participate in the 2024 **FHN** *Community Festival of Trees* which will be held at the Freeport Public Library, 100 E. Douglas Street, Freeport beginning Monday, November 25, and continuing through Monday, December 30.

Each year, many unique and beautiful trees are decorated by local not-for-profit organizations, schools, churches, and clubs for public viewing at the Library. For example, last year's winners were:

Judges' Award

- Blackhawk Elementary School, Holiday Magic Around the World 1st Place Award, \$500
- Freeport High School National Art Honor Society, Sugar Plum Fairy 2nd Place Award, \$300
- YMCA, Elves Searching for Magic in the Air 3rd Place Award, \$150

Peoples' Choice

- Open Bible Learning Center Elementary School's, The Magic of Christmas Isn't in Presents but in His Presence - 1st Place Award, \$500
- The Lincoln-Douglas First Grade, It Is Christmas in the Heart that Puts Christmas in the Air -- 2nd Place Award, \$200
- Blackhawk Elementary School, Holiday Magic Around the World 3rd Place Award, \$100

Prizes will be awarded again this year! There will be two top cash awards of \$500 each, one for first-place selection by a formal judging committee and another for the People's Choice Award, which will be determined by public voting via ballots at the Library. A second-place award of \$300 will be awarded by the judging committee, as well as a third-place award of \$150. We will give away a second place-award of \$200 and third-place award of \$100 for People's Choice.

Entries will be accepted from schools, churches, service organizations, clubs, and other officially organized not-for-profit groups (people may not enter as individuals). Judging for the prizes, other than the Peoples' Choice, will be done by a panel of local judges and will be subjective, since the trees will be works of art. However, the following criteria will apply during judging:

- Interpretation of theme selected by the entrants
- Complexity of decoration
- Perceived degree of effort
- Overall creativity

FHN will furnish the trees to be decorated for this event at no cost to your organization. You will be responsible for providing lights for your tree. The trees will be displayed throughout the Library from November 25 – December 30. All trees will be approximately six feet tall and available to decorate on Tuesday, November 20th through Saturday, November 23rd during normal library hours. You may remove decorations on Monday, December 30th through Saturday, January 4th during normal library hours. Please do not include irreplaceable decorations. FHN and the Freeport Public Library are not responsible for any damage to or theft of ornaments and other decorations. The trees themselves remain the property of FHN.

This event will be widely supported through a variety of marketing efforts, so in addition to the cash prizes, your organization will have a great opportunity to be included in a number of promotional activities. For example, FHN and the Library will host storytelling sessions at the Library during the holidays, the Frosty Family Fun event and Santa's visits and letters to Santa drop off.

Should you wish to support the overall theme of this year's Festival of Trees activities when decorating your tree, the theme is "The Best Way To Spread Holiday Cheer, Is Singing Loud For All To Hear".


